



Pimlico State High School has a nationally recognised Instrumental and Choral Program and is uniquely placed to offer musically gifted students an opportunity to enhance and enrich their skills.

THE SCHOLARSHIP

The Pimlico State High School Music Scholarship has been established to develop and support students who show an exceptional ability on one or more of the instruments offered in Education Queensland's Instrumental Music Program (brass, percussion, woodwind and brass) or exceptional ability in voice, piano or guitar.

Students will be selected by audition and interview.

The Scholarship will cover:

- One year of fees paid for Instrumental Music Levy and Instrumental Music Hire (if applicable)
- One year of fees paid for the school's Student Resource Scheme
- Contribution towards lesson fees for piano/guitar lessons at Pimlico State High School (if applicable)
- Junior Music Camp fees (If applicable)
- School based master classes and workshops with visiting artists
- A position in Pimlico State High School's Symphony Orchestra, Pimlico State High School Wind Symphony, Kingfisher Wind Ensemble, Junior Symphony or other suitable ensemble.

APPLICATIONS

To be eligible to apply for the Year 7 Scholarship the applicant must be

- In Year 6 in 2023
- Minimum Level 4 Education QLD Instrumental Music Curriculum (Grade 2 AMEB) for woodwind, brass and percussion.
- Minimum Level 6 Education QLD Instrumental Music Curriculum (Grade 3 AMEB) for Strings.
- Minimum Grade 3 AMEB or equivalent for guitar, piano and voice.

Students need to prepare two contrasting pieces and a scale demonstrating their level of ability. Duration will be 10-15 minutes, including an interview.

Application forms need to be submitted to Pimlico State High School General Office by 4pm Friday 8th September 2023. Please include a brief CV highlighting recent achievements and a reference.

Successful applicants will be notified of an audition time to be held on Thursday 19th October 2023 from 4:00pm. Notification of your audition time will be via email or phone.
