

Investing for Success

Under this agreement for 2017

Pimlico State High School will receive

\$666 800*

This funding will be used to

- Increase the proportion of **students in Years 7 to 10** attaining an **A or B level of achievement** by an average of 4% across all subject areas.
- Increase the proportion of **subject areas in which 85% of students attain a C level of achievement or better** from 80% to 90%.
- Ensure that **QCE and QCIA attainment levels are maintained at above 98%**, with the goal of all students achieving a QCE or QCIA except in the case of exceptional circumstances.

Our initiatives include

- Implement **collaborative inquiry and coaching processes** to support teachers in the implementation of the school's revised Pedagogical Framework, with an emphasis on ensuring high achieving students (as identified through NAPLAN U2B and LOA data) make adequate yearly progress.
- Implement a **Global Studies program** to develop students' higher order thinking and global citizenship skills in a contextualised and integrated manner within the Junior Secondary curriculum.
- Enhance **case management support** for Years 11 and 12 students, with a focus on groups at risk of not attaining QCE or QCIA.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Establishing a Lead Coach role to work collaboratively with our Head of Department (Teaching and Learning) to implement the school's revised Pedagogical Framework, embed a whole-of-school approach to the coaching and collaborative inquiry (**\$0 - \$120 000 carried forward from previous funding, as per 2016 I4S Agreement**)
- Continuing the role of three Support Teachers of Literacy and Numeracy (STLaN) to provide literacy and numeracy intervention for identified students at risk of not attaining a C level of achievement in core subject areas (**\$240 000**)
- Converting three classroom teacher positions to three Pedagogical Coach roles to facilitate the provision of coaching and co-planning and co-teaching support to teachers (**\$100 000**)
- Providing professional development to build the capability of the school's newly established pedagogical coaching team (**\$21 800**)
- Establishing a Head of Department (Global Education) role to lead the implementation of the school's Global Studies program (**\$120 000**)
- Continuing the role of a Head of Senior Secondary Attainment to oversee QCE monitoring, intervention and case management strategies with Years 11 and 12 students (**\$100 000**)
- Continuing the role of an Indigenous Support Officer to provide additional support in relation to the QCE attainment of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students (**\$40 000**)
- Continuing the role of an EALD Support Officer to provide additional support in relation to the QCE attainment of EALD students (**\$45 000**)
