There are some important things to remember when you are engaged in online learning from home.



Conduct yourself appropriately at all times when online. Our CARE philosophy of Cooperation, Appreciation, Respect and Effort still applies online.



Have a suitable area set up at home for your online learning. Where possible, this should be in a public area of your home, and not in your bedroom.



You do not need to wear your school uniform, but you should ensure you get dressed for the day and are appropriately attired for any video-based activities.



You will follow your normal weekly timetable each day. If there are IT issues or other disruptions, be patient and try to move on with other work for the relevant subject.



Be proactive by seeking help from your teachers if you need it. Teachers will use the timetabled lessons for each class to communicate with you and provide feedback.



Take short breaks and move around between lessons. Use your lunch breaks to eat, relax and to engage in some appropriate physical activity.



Don't spend the whole day in front of a screen. Teachers won't be actively teaching every lesson and they will set some work that can be completed off-line.



Engage with the iCARE package that will be emailed every Monday morning. It will provide useful tips about your online safety and your physical and mental wellbeing.
