P&C volunteers are dedicated parents and community members who want to contribute to the management and improvement of their school.

The Parents and Citizens' Association (P&C) is managed by an executive committee who, with other P&C members, work closely with the Executive Principal for the benefit of the students at the school.

Being involved in Pimlico's Parents and Citizens' (P&C) Association is a great way to find out what is happening at the school and how you can be a part of making Pimlico the best it can be for our own children and the wider community, for today and the future.

Our P&C usually meets on the second Tuesday of every month. Our first meeting for 2024 will be held at 7:30pm on Tuesday, 13th February in M Block (building closest to the PAC). P&C membership is free and you can choose whether to attend the regular meetings.

The P&C plays an active role across many aspects of our school. Subcommittees provide support to Pimlico's extensive Music program, as well as coordinating Team Sailing and advocating for our proposal for a new Performing Arts Centre.

The P&C also operates the school's Canteen, which is the P&C's main source of revenue. All profits from the Canteen and other P&C projects are invested directly back into the school. New Canteen volunteers are always welcome.

The P&C's Volunteer Coordinator maintains a register of volunteers' skills and talents, providing another avenue for parents and community members to get involved and help the school.

OUR AIM

We also aim to provide valuable financial help towards purchasing necessary items for the school by the P&C.

WHEN WE OPEN

We open daily at 8:15am throughout the school year. We operate before school and during recess and lunch.

HOW CAN YOU HELP THE SCHOOL AND YOUR CHILDREN?

To achieve our aims, we rely on the valuable assistance of parents and friends of the school. Mums, dads, relatives and friends of the school are invited to help in the following ways:
